CIRCULAR ON COVID GUIDELINES FOR NECESSARY ACTION AND COMPLIANCE

Dear Principal,

India is facing the second nationwide wave of Covid-19 pandemic, which has prompted some states to re-impose strict curbs, including partial and complete lockdowns, to tackle the contagion. To review the present condition, Hon'ble Minister took a meeting and shown his concern on the academic environment and further course of action.

To come out from the present difficult situation, the principals need to implement the following points in their respective institutes, as discussed in the meeting today:

1. All the Institute must encourage the students and staff to take vaccination, as the registration is now open for all 18 + years of age and the vaccination drive starts from 1st May 2021. The COVID-19 vaccination, notably, is one of the safest ways to help build protection against the virus. It is mandatory for the students to get vaccinated before the physical classes' resumes after the second wave is over.

2. India's second wave has hit with such ferocity that hospitals are running out of oxygen, beds and anti-viral drugs. People across India scrambled for life-saving oxygen supplies in last few days. The institutes must have 1or 2 "Oxygen Concentrator", keeping the staff and student strength in mind, so that they are equipped to tackle the unforeseen circumstance in future. These oxygen concentrators should be available in the premises of each institute for any emergency use.
